

Data Collection

1. It is our policy not to collect any user's personal data, other than:
2. Direct interactions. You may give us your Identity, Contact and Financial Data by filling in forms or by corresponding with us by post, phone, email, internet or otherwise.
3. Automated technologies or interactions. As you interact with our website, we may automatically collect Technical Data about your equipment, browsing actions and patterns. We may collect this personal data using cookies or analytical technologies. Where we do apply such technologies, we will place a cookie or equivalent policy on the relevant web site. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when websites set or access cookies. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of this website may become inaccessible or not function properly.
4. Third parties or publicly available sources. We may receive personal data about you from various third parties and public sources.
5. Contact, Financial and Transaction Data from providers of technical, payment and delivery services based [inside OR outside] the EU.
6. Identity and Contact Data from data brokers or aggregators based [inside OR outside] the EU.
7. Identity and Contact Data from publicly available sources such as Companies Registration Office and the Electoral Register based inside the EU.

Personal information provided will be solely for the purposes of

1. Responding to your queries
2. Process financial applications under funding schemes operated solely or partly by Breeding Waders EIP
3. Communicating local, national, or international Breeding Waders EIP related information of relevance

Security

Our websites have security measures in place to protect the loss, misuse, and alteration of the information under our control. However, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure, but it is our policy to ensure our security system adheres to the highest standards.

Embedded content from other websites

Who we share your data with

Personal data collected may be shared with Local Authorities, Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage and the Environmental Protection Agency. We require all third parties to enter into a data processing agreement with us which complies with our obligations under the GDPR. This agreement requires third parties to have appropriate security systems in place and only to use your personal data on our instructions and in accordance with data protection law.

For the purposes of analysing visitor traffic, we record the number of visitors to the websites, which is used for statistical purposes. This information does not contain any personal data.

Data Storage and Security

Personal data is stored securely on encrypted servers with access limited to authorised personnel. Physical documents are securely stored and disposed of when no longer needed. After the required retention period, data will be securely deleted or anonymised.

What rights you have over your data

Participants have the following rights under GDPR:

- Right to access their personal data
- Right to rectify inaccurate or incomplete data
- Right to request data erasure (subject to legal obligations)
- Right to restrict or object to processing
- Right to data portability, Requests can be submitted to info@breedingwaders.ie, and responses will be provided within one month.

You can also request that we erase any personal data we hold about you. This does not include any data we are obliged to keep for administrative, legal, or security purposes.
